

OFFICIAL CALL

Mass Meeting of the Caroline County Republican Committee's 1st District of the Republican Party of Virginia

As Chairman of the Caroline County Republican Committee of the Republican Party of Virginia, and pursuant to the Plan of Organization and as recommended and directed by the Committee, I, Jeff Sili, do hereby issue this call for a Mass Meeting to be held at the Caroline County Courthouse, 123 N. Main Street, Bowling Green, VA 22427, starting at 7:00pm local time on April 2, 2010, for the following purposes:

1. Electing up to 50 Delegates and an equal number of Alternates to cast 10 votes at the **First Congressional District Republican Convention to be held on May 15, 2010 at the Caroline County High School, 19155 Rogers Clark Blvd., Milford, VA. 22514, beginning at 1:00 PM local time for the purpose of electing a First District Chairman, and transacting such other business as may properly come before the convention.** Each unit is entitled to one (1) Delegate Vote per 500 Republican votes for Governor and President at their last election, so that the Caroline Republican Committee is entitled to 10 Delegate votes
2. Any other business as may properly come before the mass meeting.

Qualifications for Participation

All legal and qualified voters of Caroline County Virginia County's 1st District under the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia, regardless of race, religion, national origin or sex, who are in accord with the principles of the Republican Party and who, if requested, express in open meeting either orally or in writing, as may be required, their intent to support all of its nominees for public office in the ensuing election, may participate as members of the Republican Party of Virginia in its mass meetings, party canvasses, conventions or primaries encompassing their respective election districts.

In addition to the foregoing, to be in accord with the principles of the Republican Party, unless otherwise stipulated by the appropriate Official Committee, a person otherwise qualified hereunder shall not have participated in Virginia in the nomination process of a party other than the Republican Party after March 1, 2004, or in the last five years, whichever is more recent. A single exception to this shall be approved for a voter that renounces affiliation with any other party in writing, and who expresses in writing that he/she is in accord with the principles of the Republican Party and intends, at the time of the writing, to support the nominees of the Republican Party in the future. Any voter that utilizes the foregoing exception, and thereafter participates in the nomination process of a party other than the Republican Party, shall not have the benefit of this exception thereafter.

Voters may be required to produce personal identification such as a valid driver's license or voter registration card.

Registration Fee

There will be no registration fee required to participate in this mass meeting, but a voluntary contribution of \$10 per participant is requested.

Mass Meeting Registration

Registration to participate in the Mass Meeting will begin no sooner than 6:30pm local time and end no earlier than 7:00pm local time. Registration time may be extended at the direction of the Chairman. All persons in line at 7:00pm local time will be allowed to register. Proxies will not be allowed.

Candidate Pre-File Requirements

All candidates for 2010 Convention Delegates are required to pre-file their intentions by completely and properly submitting the delegate pre-registration form to the Caroline County Republican Committee, 205 Travis Street, Bowling Green, VA 22427, which MUST be received not later than 5:00pm local time Thursday, April 1, 2010. Post-marks do not govern.

Applications will also be accepted in person to Jeff Sili, 205 Travis Street, Bowling Green, VA 22427 prior to 5:00pm local time Friday, March 20, 2009. No candidates for Delegate may be nominated from the floor. Pre-Registration form may be downloaded at www.northernneckrepublicans.org
